1994: B52 Fairchild AFB (con'd)

- General context
 - Practice for an upcoming airshow
 - Captain was known for his:
 - → Lack of discipline,
 - Dangerous and reckless flying
 - and this for years
 - All squadron FOs declined to fly with the Captain
 - No Air force officer ranked higher than the commander of the unit ever questioned the Captain flying status
 - After the Captain flew over a mountain with a 30 feet clearance the commander of the unit:
 - Decide to pull the Captain flying status after the airshow
 - Forbid anyone else from flying with him
 - Was in the copilot seat when the plane goes down

1994: B52 Fairchild AFB (con'd)

- Operational context
 - US Air Force authorize only 30° bank during airshows
 - 92nd Bomb Wing officers cleared the Captain to perform "more aggressive" maneuvers during the airshow
 - One of the maneuvers:
 - 360° turn centered over the tower
 - ♦ 60° bank angle
 - → At 250 feet

1994: B52 Fairchild AFB (end)

- Flying context
 - During the 360° turn over the tower
 - At mid turn, the B52 was in a 90° angle of bank
 - Aircraft lost lift
 - Hit the ground at 95° bank angle and 150 kts
 - Copilot
 - Ejected, obviously realizing that they were going down,
 - But fell down in the fire ball created by the impact.
