1995: A320 Paris

- General context
 - Commercial flight
 - 125 pax
 - Boarding completed
- Situational context
 - Cabin is filled with thick smoke (coming from APU)
 - Captain:
 - Is alerted by ground personnel and by CA1
 - Stop APU
 - Ask the CA1 in the cockpit to evacuate the cabin
 - but does not mention which doors to use)
 - Use the PA to order the evacuation
 - but the PA is not working properly

1995: A320 Paris (con'd)

Evacuation

- CP
 - Is in the jetway dealing with luggage issue
 - She noticed the smoke and flames from outside the APU
 - She hear the evacuation order given by the Captain while going to the cabin
 - Use the PA to order PAX to leave through L1 but PA stopped working
 - ✗ Goes to the cabin to help the evacuation assisted by CA2

1995: A320 Paris (con'd)

- Evacuation (end)
 - CA4
 - Is at the aft of the aircraft
 - Did hear CP message but is not sure to have understood fully
 - Without receiving any clear instruction and facing the aggressive attitude of pax
 - Arm and open L2
 - Some passengers do no want to use the slide
 - 25 people used L2
 - 100 people used L1
 - At the end of the evacuation cabin is clear of smoke.

1995: A320 Paris (end)

Analysis

- Evacuation took 2 mn
- Captain and CP thought pax will leave only through L1
- CA did not used an emergency language to guide pax to L1
- CA stated they faced difficulties with pax taking their cabin bags
- Some passengers stopped in the jetway to discuss jamming the evacuation.
